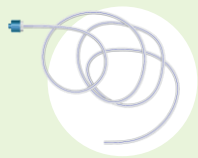


# Playing a Vital Role in Protecting Public Health

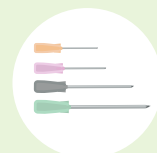

## Operating Safely

- Voluntarily installed enhancements to our emission control systems in 2019 despite already operating safely and in full compliance with our Georgia EPD permit and applicable regulations
- On January 6, the Georgia EPD completed the permit process related to the emissions control enhancements
- The new permit reflects some of the most stringent controls in the world and follows months of review, including GA EPD inspections and third-party tests that verified the effectiveness of the additional state-of-the-art emissions control enhancements
- Sterigenics is committed to complying with these stringent new requirements while continuing to safely perform its vital work to meet the demands of our nation's healthcare system
